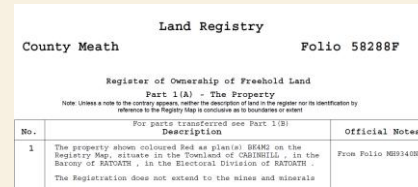

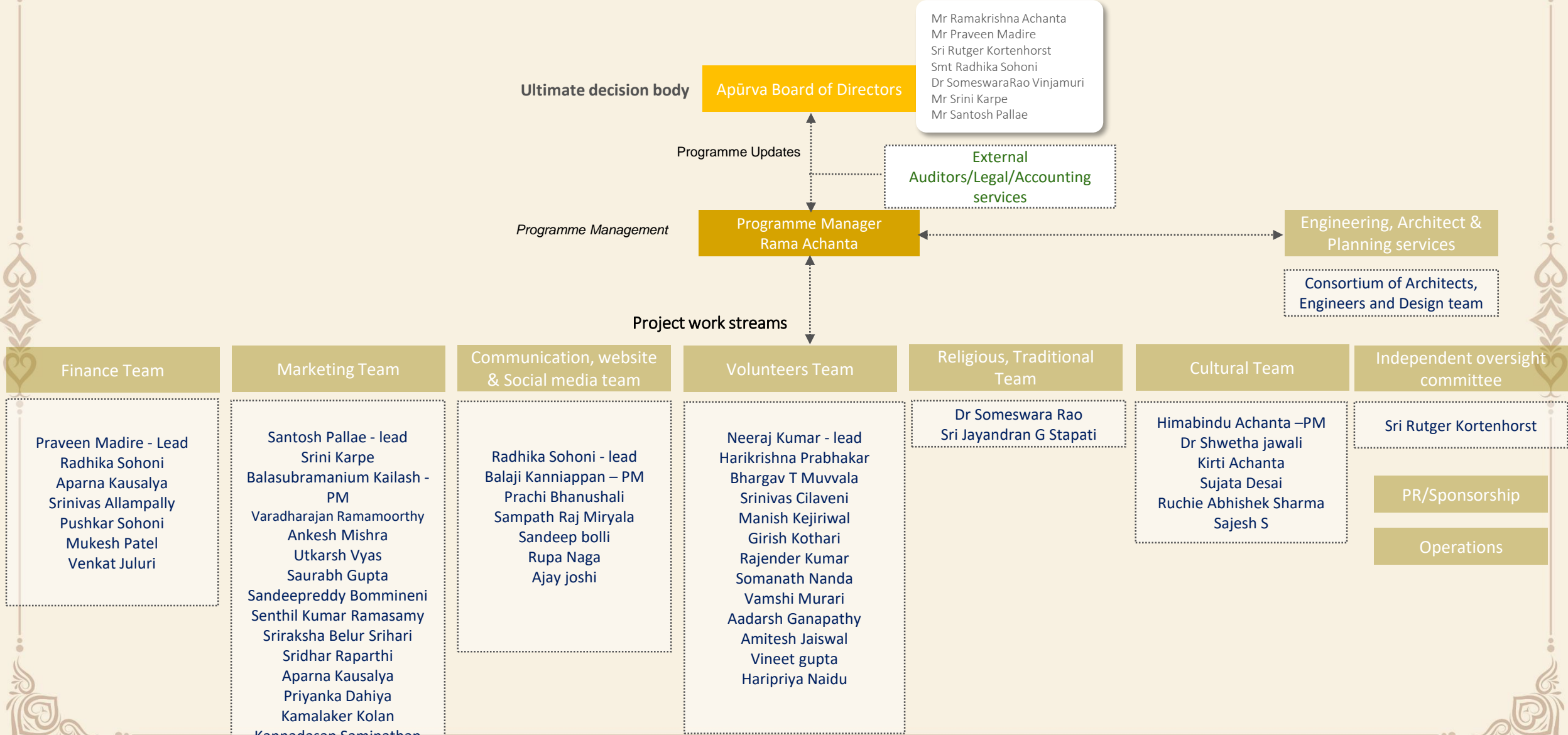

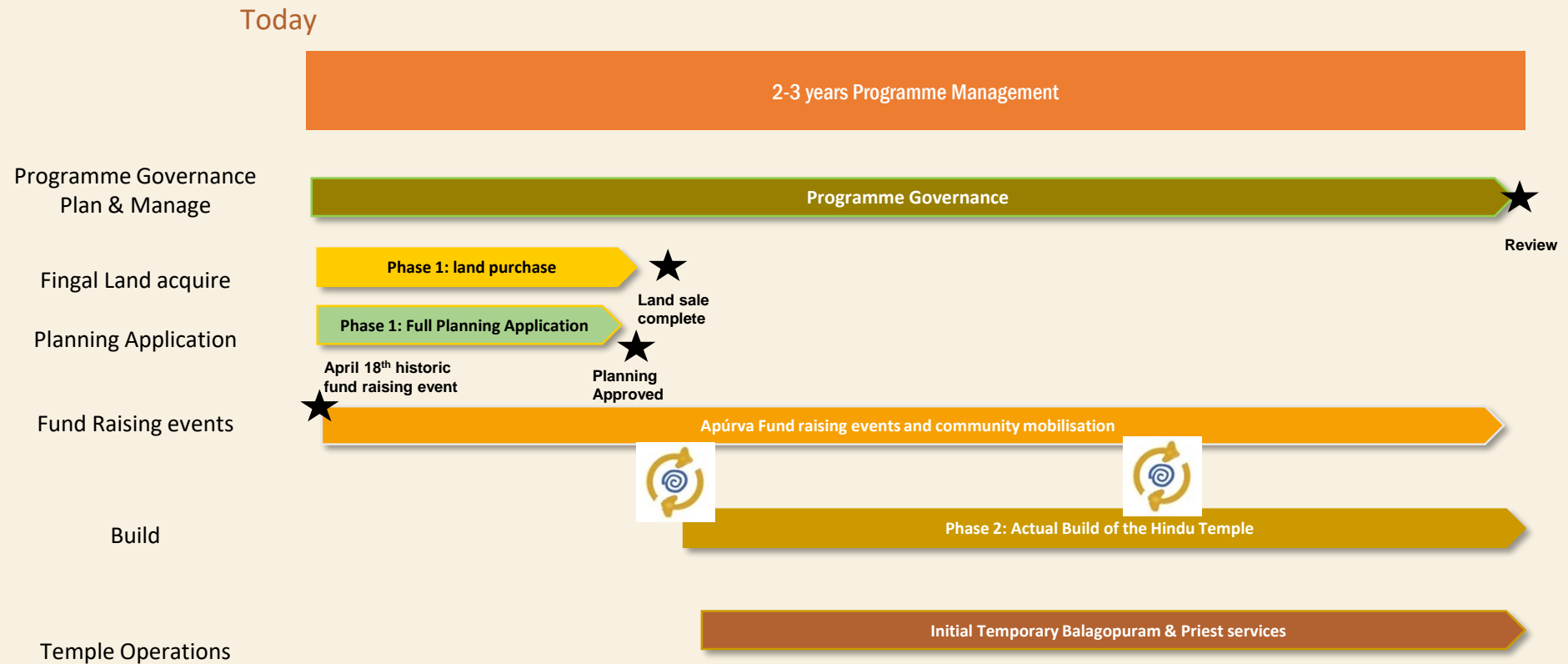
Governance Structure

Apūrva: Plan Overview

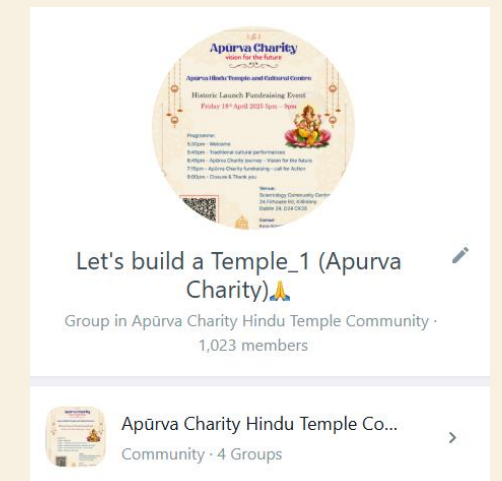
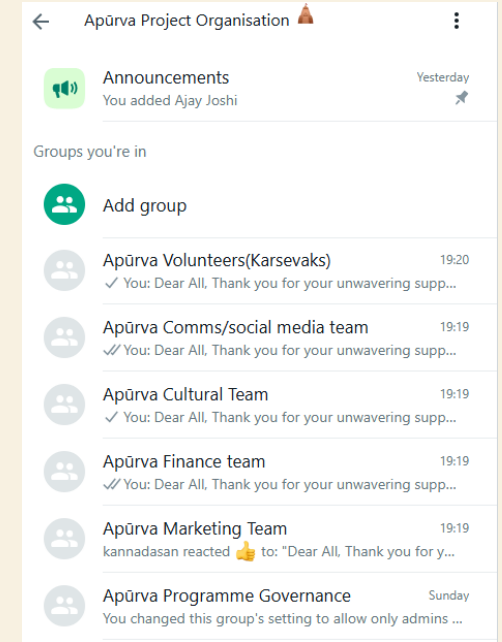

Apūrva: Ethos

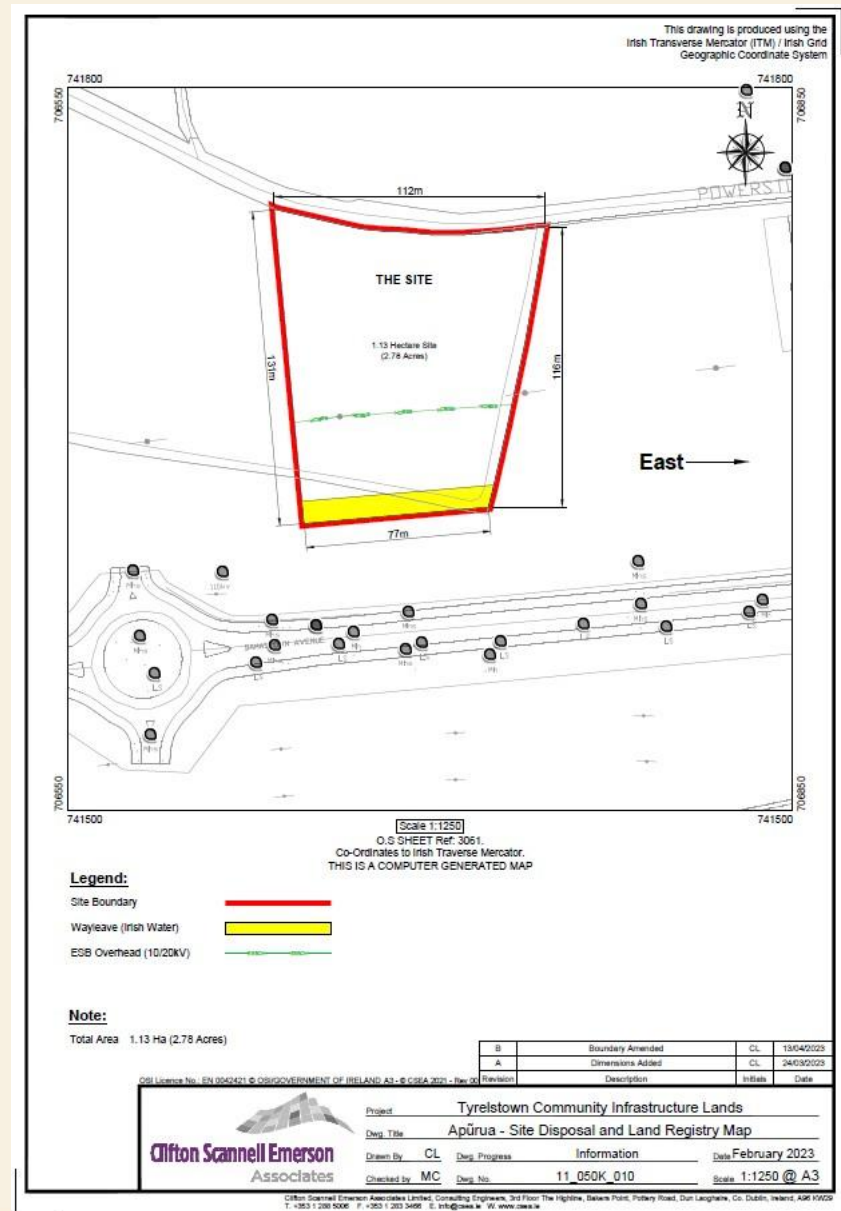
- The **right attitude** and commitment to support the vision.

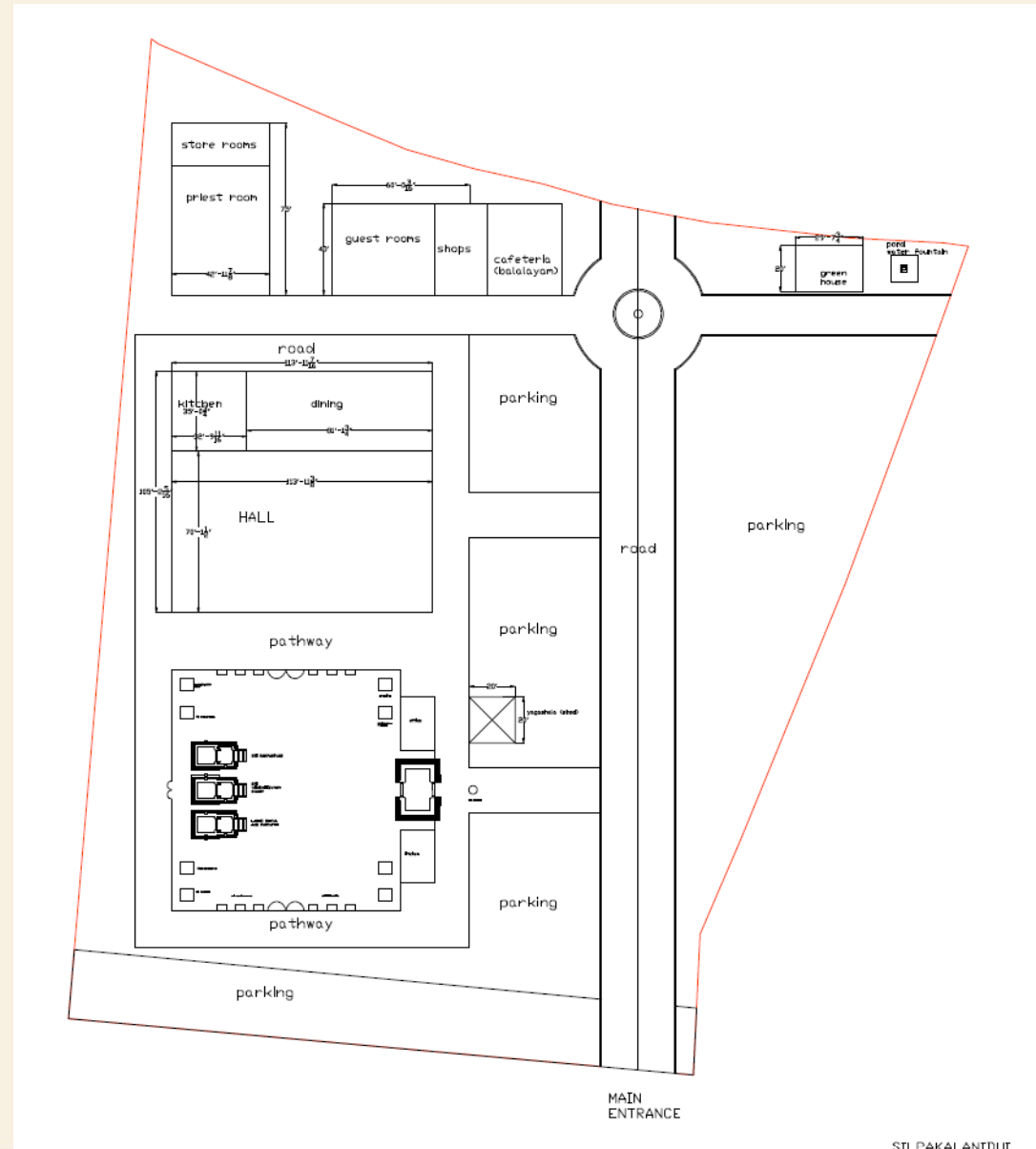

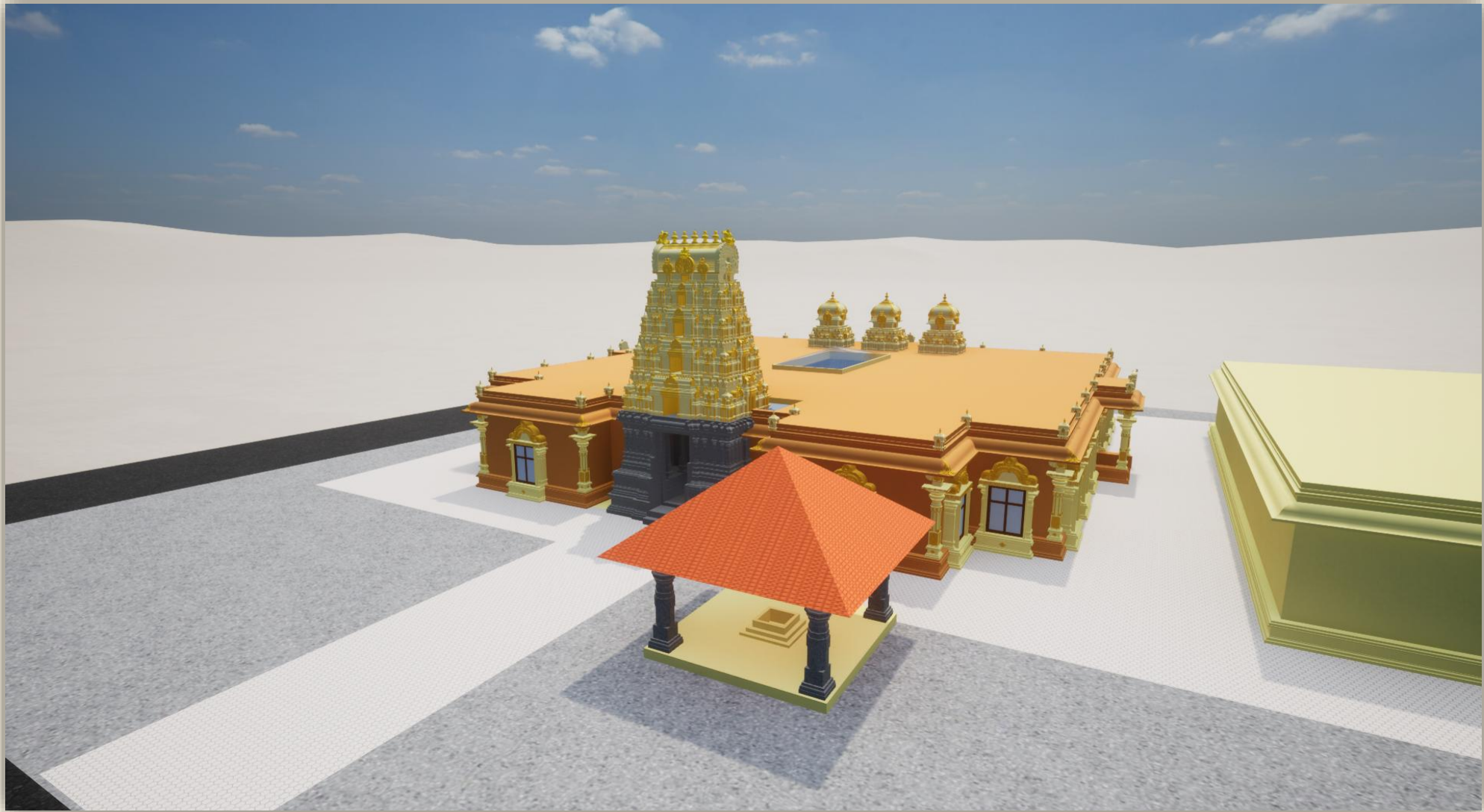
Fingal 2.78 acres CI Zoned land for Apūrva Charity

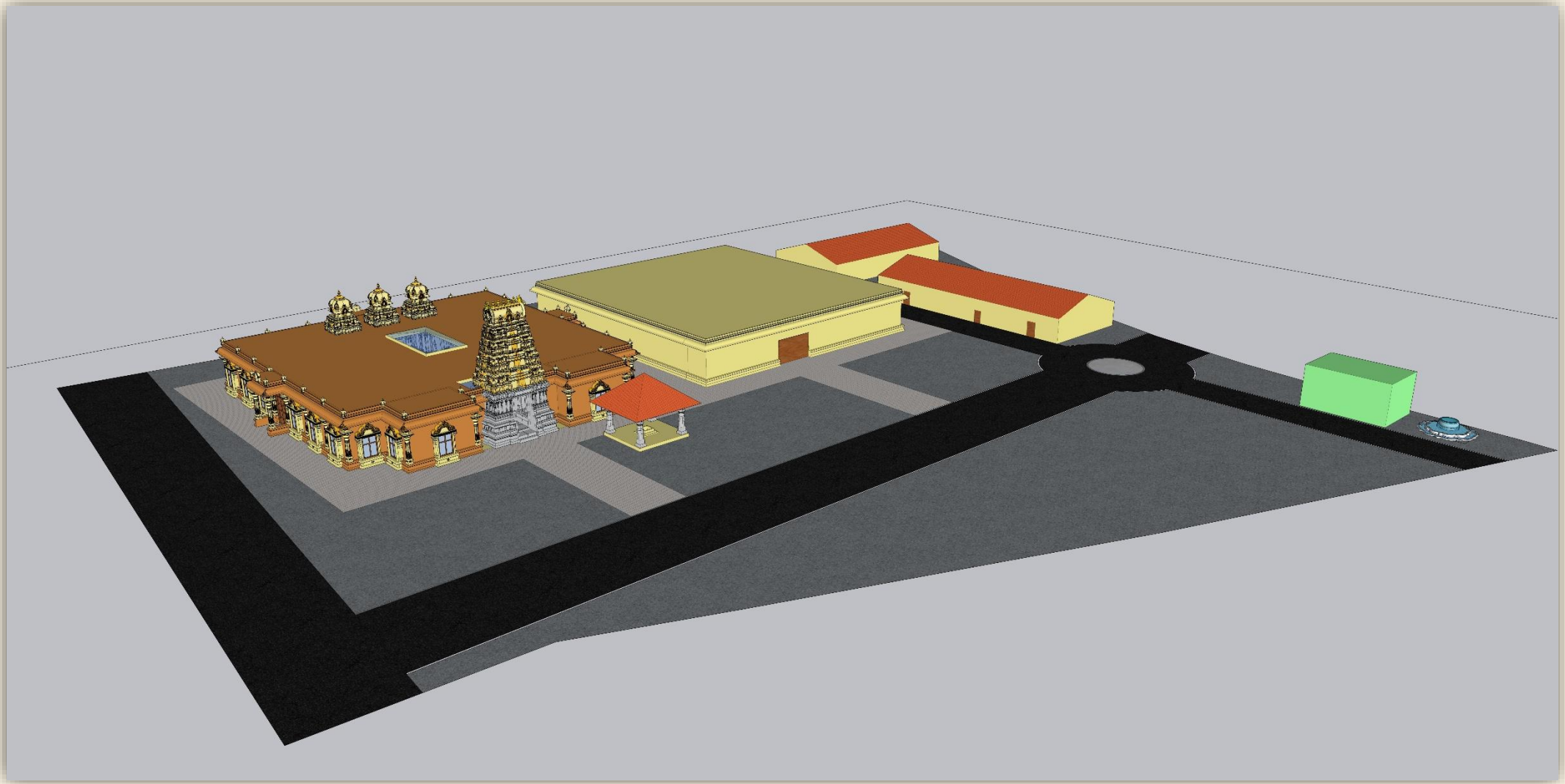
