

## Apūrva: Plan Overview



## Apūrva: Ethos


- The **right attitude** and commitment to support the vision.











Fingal 2.78 acres CI Zoned land for Apūrva Charity



# Apūrva Hindu Temple and Cultural Centre: Layout




## Apūrva Hindu Temple: Entrance View


## Apūrva Hindu Temple: Temple View


